The workshop will also consider any changes to the information disclosure (ID) requirements to support our emerging view on our assessment of airport profitability. This workshop will be held in the Sunderland Room at Wellington Airport on **26 April 2016**. It will run from 9.00am – 4.30pm, and will be facilitated by staff from the Commerce Commission.

The purpose of this workshop is to present Commission staff's emerging view on the approach to assessing profitability with a view to discussing the pros and cons of possible solutions to the problems identified in the first workshop with interested parties.
