



## Commerce Commission – Input methodologies review – Stakeholder engagement

Good afternoon

Thank you to all our stakeholders for your engagement with the IM review process so far. It has significantly helped to inform our understanding of the specific problems and potential solutions.

We are now in the process of writing up our draft decisions and reasons for publication.

As such, we anticipate that apart from any engagements already arranged, including the Airports Profitability and Gas DPP workshops (see note below), we will not be seeking further engagement with stakeholders on matters affecting the IM review until after the publication of our draft decisions.

We are on track for releasing our draft decisions in mid-June 2016, and aim to provide stakeholders with a more specific publication date in mid-May. As indicated in our notification email of 31 March 2016, we expect to allow six weeks for submissions and two weeks for cross submissions following the publication of our draft decisions.

Note: As advised in our notification email of 18 April 2016 on the Gas DPP, a workshop on quality of service is scheduled for 24 May 2016. We can now confirm that we will hold a workshop on constant price revenue growth on the following day, 25 May 2016.
