

Subject : Commerce Commission - Notice that Aurora's CPP application has been accepted as complete and IM compliant

Tēnā koutou

Aurora Energy has applied to the Commission for approval of a customised price-quality path (CPP) to spend up to \$383 million over the next three years (or \$609 million over five years) to address safety and reliability issues on its network. Aurora Energy's CPP application was published on our [web site](#) on 12 June 2020. We are currently seeking your feedback on our *Key issues paper*. Submissions on our paper close on 20 August 2020.

As a preliminary step in our consideration of Aurora Energy's application, we must determine whether it complies with our input methodologies (IMs) relating to the process for, and content of, CPP proposals.

The Commission determined on 7 August 2020 that Aurora Energy's CPP application complies with our IMs relating to the process for, and content of, a CPP proposal and gives this notice under section 53T(1)(a) of the Commerce Act 1986 that Aurora Energy's CPP proposal is now under consideration by the Commission.

Our draft decision on Aurora Energy's CPP proposal will be published in November 2020. Our final decision on the CPP proposal will be made in March 2021.
