

# Notice to supply information and documents to the Commerce Commission Sections 98(a) and (b) Commerce Act 1986

## **Purpose of the Notice**

- 1. We (the Commerce Commission) are reviewing the price to be paid for the Unbundled Bitstream Access (UBA) service provided by Chorus Limited as defined in subpart 1 of Part 2 of Schedule 1 of the Telecommunications Act 2001 (Act). We are required to make reasonable efforts to make a price review determination before the expiry of three years from separation day, which is 30 November 2014 (refer s78(3) of the Telecommunications (TSO, Broadband, and Other Matters) Amendment Act 2011).
- 2. The purpose of this Notice is to obtain information and documents relevant to our price review.
- 3. The Notice is issued under sections 98(a) and (b) of the Commerce Act, and s15(f) of the Act.
- 4. We consider it is necessary and desirable for Vodafone New Zealand Limited to provide us with the information and documents specified in **Attachment A** to this Notice to assist us in making the price review determination.

## Date and place of response

- 5. The information and documents in response to this Notice must be delivered to the Commission's Wellington office at Level 6, 44 The Terrace for the attention of Keston Ruxton, or by email to <a href="mailto:telco@comcom.govt.nz">telco@comcom.govt.nz</a> with the subject "Response to section 98 Notice UBA", by 5pm on Friday 7 March 2014.
- 6. Vodafone New Zealand Limited must provide all information and documents in electronic .csv format, via email or on a flash drive.
- 7. Vodafone New Zealand Limited must label and identify all information and documentation, explaining to the Commission how it relates to this Notice.

Vodafone New Zealand Limited must supply the requested information and 8. documents under cover of a letter on Vodafone New Zealand's letterhead, signed by a person with the appropriate authority.

#### Attachment A

- 1. For the purposes of this Notice, the following terms have the following meanings:
  - 1.1. Vodafone New Zealand Limited means Vodafone New Zealand Limited, its interconnected bodies corporate (as defined in section 2(7) of the Commerce Act), business units or joint ventures, and any current or former agents, employees, officers and directors thereof.
  - 1.2. **RBI** means the parts of the Rural Broadband Initiative that are relevant to Vodafone New Zealand Limited.
  - 1.3. **Non-RBI** means services provided by Vodafone New Zealand Limited not covered by the RBI.
  - 1.4. **RBI Handover** means the network node where the RBI service is handed over to the wholesale customer.

### Information and documents requested

- 2. Please provide the following:
  - 2.1. For each RBI end-user:
    - 2.1.1. End-user unique identifier;
    - 2.1.2. The geographic location (X, Y co-ordinates) of each end user premise;
    - 2.1.3. The traffic profiles by end-user by service (including Non-RBI services). This should include historical time series (by month), and connection and traffic forecasts; and
    - 2.1.4. End-user-RBI site mapping that identifies the RBI site ID the end-user is served off, or within range of (this should include any site propagation maps).
  - 2.2. RBI Customer Premise Equipment (CPE) and Installation:
    - 2.2.1. The technical specification and unit cost of end-user CPE provided to RBI end-users;
    - 2.2.2. Service company installation cost per premise for connecting the RBI service.
  - 2.3. For each RBI site:
    - 2.3.1. RBI site unique identifier;
    - 2.3.2. The geographic location (X, Y co-ordinates) of each RBI site;
    - 2.3.3. RBI site-RBI Handover mapping that identifies the RBI Handover identifier at which the RBI traffic is handed-over (to either the wholesale customer, or non-RBI commercial service);

- 2.3.4. The geographic location (X, Y co-ordinates) of each RBI Handover.
- 3. To the extent that Vodafone holds this information, the Commission seeks cost information relating to the deployment of fibre to Vodafone RBI sites.
  - 3.1. The geographic start and end points (X, Y co-ordinates) and distance of each duct; and
  - 3.2. Itemised trenching and associated deployment costs of each duct, and the completion date.
