Targeted ID Review (2024) draft decision: Request for cross-submissions on specific matters

On Wednesday 20 September 2023 we published the submissions received on the draft decision - reasons paper for our targeted information disclosure (ID) review (2024), focussing on electricity distribution businesses (EDBs), and we invited all interested parties to review and cross-submit on these submissions. These submissions can be found on our webpage here.

We would like to highlight, and specifically request cross-submissions on the alternative proposals put forward by submitters on our proposed amendments to:

- schedule 9c and schedule 10 as part of issue AM6 vegetation management reporting, and
- the definition of non-traditional solutions and associated definitions as part of D5 work and investment on flexibility resources.

We note that we are not requesting cross-submissions exclusively on these matters, and submitters are still encouraged to cross-submit on matters raised in submissions as they see fit.

Cross-submissions are due by 5pm on Thursday, 5 October 2023

We invite all interested parties to review and cross-submit on submissions by 5pm on Thursday, 5 October 2023.

Please email your submission to infrastructure.regulation@comcom.govt.nz with 'EDB Targeted ID Review (2024)' in the subject line of your email. We prefer submissions in formats suitable for data analysis, and for publication on our website, such as a Microsoft Word or a PDF document.

We intend to publish all cross-submissions on our website, unless you indicate to us that your cross-submission, or parts of it, are confidential. When providing a cross-submission that is not labelled as confidential, please confirm in the cover email that you are happy for that cross submission to be published on our website. If it is necessary to include confidential material in a cross-submission, the information should be clearly marked, and

both confidential and public versions of the cross-submission should be provided and clearly labelled accordingly.

We thank the many submitters that have engaged with our submission process in the Targeted ID Review (2024). If you do not receive acknowledgement of your cross-submission from us within two working days, please do not hesitate to contact me. We look forward to receiving your cross-submissions.
