## 3 Introduction

Wellington Electricity Lines Limited (**WELL**) welcomes the opportunity to make a submission to the Commerce Commission on its consultation paper on the *proposed amendments to input methodologies for electricity distribution businesses – wash-up amounts*.

## 4 WELL supports the proposed amendments

As noted in the Commerce Commission's draft decision reasons paper<sup>1</sup>, "the transitional arrangements for the revenue washup provided in the EDB IMs do not function as intended". This results in an inability to draw down the RY24 wash-up account balance in the first year of DPP4.

WELL supports the Commerce Commission's [Draft] Electricity Distribution Services Input Methodologies (Wash-up Amounts) Amendment Determination 2024<sup>2</sup>. We agree that:

- the proposed amendments will give effect to the intent of the IMs by correcting this technical error; and
- the amendments to clauses (5)(a)(ii) and (12) provide greater clarity around how to calculate and implement the time value of money adjustments to wash-up calculations.
