

Process paper on Chorus' proposed New UBA Variants

Date: 30 May 2014

Purpose

 This paper outlines our process for deciding whether the New UBA Variants proposed by Chorus fall within the existing UBA Service Description outlined in Schedule 1 of the Standard Terms Determination for Chorus' Unbundled Bitstream Access Service (UBA STD).¹

Chorus' Notice of New UBA Variants

- Chorus provided the Commission with Notice on 14 May 2014 that it is proposing to offer two commercial UBA services (referred to here as New UBA Variants), Boost HD and Boost VDSL, in accordance with Clause 10 UBA STD.
- 3. Chorus intends to launch these New UBA Variants on 1 September 2014. For more information on these services, please see Chorus' Notice and supporting documents available here.

Our process

- 4. We previously set out a process for assessing New UBA Variants in May 2010. We followed that process when assessing Telecom's proposed Wholesale VDSL2 Service later that year.²
- 5. We propose to follow a modified version of that process in which we will publish, and seek submissions on, a draft decision regarding whether Chorus' proposed New UBA Variants fall within the existing UBA Service Description, compared to only seeking submissions on Chorus' proposal.
- 6. This approach recognises the substantial level of industry interest in the current final pricing principle review of the UBA price. We believe that it is important that all interested parties are able to comment on any Commission decision that may be relevant to the scope of the regulated service.
