Official Information Act #21.167 - Clean Car discount scheme

- 1. We refer to your request transferred to the Commerce Commission (**Commission**) from Waka Kotahi New Zealand Transport Agency (**NZTA**) on 13 April 2022 for information about what price monitoring activity the Government is undertaking in relation to the NZTA Clean Car discount scheme to ensure that vehicle dealerships are not taking advantage of the scheme, and what enforcement action, if any, is intended to be taken against dealerships who exploit the rebate system.
- 2. We have treated this as a request for information under the Official Information Act 1982 (**OIA**).

Our response

- 3. We have decided to grant your request.
- 4. The Commission is responsible for enforcing laws relating to fair trading, to ensure consumers are protected, and clear and accurate information is provided to them. As a general rule, businesses are free to set their own prices, including raising prices, but must not mislead consumers as to any reasons given for a price increase. You can find further information about your rights as a consumer on our website.¹
- 5. The Commission is not tasked with a price monitoring role but any person who thinks a business is breaching one of the laws we enforce can make a complaint to us, which will be assessed against our enforcement criteria.²
