Upper South Island Reliability Stage 1 Major Capex Proposal Approval

We are pleased to advise you that we have approved the reliability component of the Upper South Island reliability stage 1 major capex proposal. The maximum approved amount for the proposal is \$4.99 million.

In approving this proposal, we note that Transpower has agreed that it will:

- monitor observed demand and adjust the need date of stage 1 and subsequent stages accordingly;
- develop a solution to reduce the modification costs of reactive power controllers each time there is a project that affects reactive power.

Your original application dated 29 June 2012 included a reliability component and a component to mitigate high impact low probability risks at Islington substation (HILP). On 27 September 2012, you advised us to defer our decision on the HILP component until further advice from Transpower. Therefore, we have not made any decisions on the HILP component of the application.
