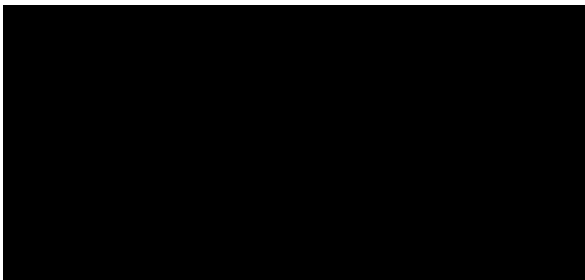

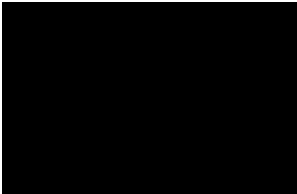
3. We have decided to grant your request.
