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1 Introduction

- 1.1 This schedule sets out the Charges¹ for the Sub-loop Backhaul Service and provides a mechanism to make adjustments to the Charges for Service Components².
- 1.2 References to clauses or sections are references to clauses or sections in this Sub-loop Backhaul Price List unless expressly provided otherwise. The definitions set out in the Sub-loop Services General Terms and the Sub-loop Backhaul Operations Manual apply to the extent that they are not expressly modified by or inconsistent with the context of this Sub-loop Backhaul Price List.

2 Charges

- 2.1 All Prices³ are listed under the "Charge" column for each Service Component
- 2.2 Charges for Sub-loop Backhaul Service Components are described as being either a Core ('C') or Sundry ('S') Charge.
- 2.3 Core Charges are for the core components of the Sub-loop Backhaul Service.
- 2.4 **Sundry Charges** are for other components of the Sub-loop Backhaul Service.
- 2.5 Prices for Service Components are either:
 - 2.5.1 fixed: or
 - 2.5.2 calculated; or
 - 2.5.3 expressed as "Price on application" (**POA**). Prices that are POA must reflect the underlying cost of providing the resources and project management skills required to provide the Service Component.
- 2.6 For all Service Components that are POA, Chorus must, if requested by the Access Seeker, use all reasonable endeavours to provide the Access Seeker with two or more competitive quotes.
- 2.7 Charges will become due and payable and will be invoiced in the manner described in the "Charge invoiced" column for each Service Component.
- 2.8 The provisions in the Sub-loop Services General Terms relating to invoicing and payment of Charges apply.
- 2.9 All adjustments to Prices must be done in accordance with the Price Change Mechanism listed in the "Price Change Mechanism" column for each Service Component.
- 2.10 Any adjustment to Charges for Service Components must be approved by the Commission.

Charge is defined in the Sub-loop Services General Terms as "all or (as the context requires) any amounts payable by the Access Seeker under the Sub-loop Services Terms." Charges in this schedule exclude GST.

Service Component means a component of the Sub-loop Co-location Service, described in the rows of tables 1-3 below. Each Service Component has a description of the service, a Price Change Mechanism, invoicing detail and a Charge, which is identified as either Core or Sundry. Individual Service Components are referred to by the numerical reference number at the start of the row in which the Service Component is described.

Price in this document means the dollar amount(s) attributed to a Service Component. A Price becomes a Charge when the Access Seeker requests/receives the Service. Prices in this schedule exclude GST.

3 Adjustment to Charges

- 3.1 Chorus must, subject to the approval of the Commission, pass through changes in costs by increasing or decreasing Prices as follows:
 - 3.1.1 Each year, on 1 November, Chorus must calculate adjustments to the Prices relating to the Service Components where this clause is the prescribed Price Change Mechanism below. Those adjustments must be by an amount equivalent to the percentage change (up or down) for the previous year in the Labour Cost Index (All sectors, Salary and Ordinary Time Wage Rates, All industries combined) Series Reference LCIQ.SG51Z9 as published by Statistics New Zealand or such successor index as may be designated by Statistics New Zealand from time-to-time.

For the purpose of this clause 3.1.1 the annual percentage change between the previous year's June index number and the current year's June index number must be used.

- 3.1.2 Where:
 - 3.1.2.1 the cost of providing one of the Service Components (with the prescribed Price Change Mechanism "clause 3.1.2") increases or decreases; and
 - 3.1.2.2 that increase or decrease is due to changes in input costs charged to Chorus pursuant to contractual obligations by its field service company contractors,

Chorus must immediately calculate an adjustment to the Price relating to that Service Component to reflect the increase or decrease in costs

- 3.1.3 When adjusting Prices under clause 3.1Chorus must review all Service Components which are POA and calculate a fixed Price where this is practicable.
- 3.2 Once an adjustment or new fixed Price has been calculated under clause 3.1, Chorus must give notice to the Commission of the adjustment. The notice must include:
 - 3.2.1 the figures used in the calculation for the adjustment;
 - 3.2.2 the calculations undertaken for the adjustment;
 - 3.2.3 a description of the adjustment made; and
 - 3.2.4 the reasons for the increase or decrease.
- 3.3 After an adjustment calculation has been approved by the Commission, Chorus must:
 - 3.3.1 notify Access Seekers of the adjustment; and then,
 - activate the new Charge arising from the adjustment in its billing system within 30 Working Days of the Commission notifying Chorus of its approval.
