

## AMENDED NOTICE OF INTENTION AT 14 SEPTEMBER 2016

## (Further amending the amended Notice of Intention dated 2 December 2015) Input Methodologies Review

- The purpose of this amended Notice of Intention is to further amend the amended Notice of Intention dated 2 December 2015,<sup>1</sup> to reflect updates to the timeline for completing the Input Methodologies Review (IM Review) in respect of three specific matters.
- 2. The scope of the IM review, as set out in the amended Notice of Intention dated 2 December 2015, remains unchanged. The timing remains unchanged except as specified below.
- 3. The Commission's June 2016 draft decisions package presented draft decisions on all input methodologies within the scope of the IM review except the input methodologies for:
  - a. the Transpower Incremental Rolling Incentive Scheme (IRIS) input methodology;
  - b. the input methodologies relating to CPP information requirements for gas; and
  - c. the related party transaction input methodologies.
- 4. While these areas are still within the scope of the IM review, we have not yet reached draft decisions on them.
- 5. In accordance with sections 52Y(3) and 52V(1) of the Act, this notice sets out in the table overleaf the revised timelines for reaching draft and final decisions on these input methodologies.
