Final report on whether Spark's three resale services should be omitted from Schedule 1 of the Telecommunications Act 2001

Dear Minister,

Please find attached our final report on whether Spark's three resale services should be omitted from Schedule 1 of the Telecommunications Act 2001 (Act).

We started our investigation into whether Spark's three resale services should be omitted from Schedule 1 of the Act on 14 July 2016. We finalised our investigation today after consultation with interested parties.

Clause 4(3)(a) of Schedule 3 requires us to provide details of the "proposed alteration" in our final report. The proposed alteration is to omit the three resale services from Schedule 1.

Clause 4(3)(b) of Schedule 3 requires us to make two recommendations:

- whether the proposed alteration should be made; and
- whether the proposed alteration should be deferred by the Minister.

We recommend that the Minister:

- does not omit the three resale services from Schedule 1 at this time; and
- defers the decision on whether to omit the three resale services from Schedule 1 for two years from the date of our final report.

If the Minister accepts our recommendation to defer the decision, we will provide another report at the end of the 2-year period, as required by the Act.

There are no dissenting views from Commissioners regarding the above recommendations.
